The trip was extremely successful. I managed to collect **226** bird species where **92** birds were new to me. Most of them were seen and some were heard calling, I saw **19** mammals plus **5** reptiles. since Dion is an expert he had the roars of the leopard “Did you hear a leopard calling near Apoka lodge where I had my night at around 04:00am -05:30am Harriet “Dion greeted me that way the last day we were leaving the park back to Kitgum. I replied with a big “No”. He is real an international tour leader.

Among many birds and mammals the following were some of the highlights of the trip that mostly caught my eyes ,Rose ringed Parakeet ,Pearl spotted Owlet ,Spotted eagle Owl, Secretary Bird, Black- breasted Barbet , Yellow bellied Hyliota, Yellow- bellied Eramomela,Green-backed Eramomela, Stone Partridge, Rock- loving Cisticola, Fox Kestral, Red winged Pytilia, Brown-backed Wood pecker, Fox Cisticola,mammals include **2** male lions, **2** Elands common zebra, to mention but few.

## DAY 1

Our trip resumed on 29<sup>th</sup> June at 5:00am with rain drizzles. What a blessing! Ibrahim the driver guide and I picked Dion at Boma Hotel in Entebbe where he spent his night. Mark Bankunda joined us from Kawempe but unfortunately stopped in Gulu due to fever. He came back to Kampala for further treatment. We missed him! However on our way from Entebbe to Kitgum (Travas Hotel) where we spent a night, we had stopovers to stretch up as well as birding where I managed to see 50 birds and many olive Baboons around Karuma Dam who were eagerly waiting for treats from travellers. We had break coffee at the Kabalega Dinnings and packed lunch in a good tree shade alongside the road. I saw the following birds.
